Welcome to our November Newsletter which comes complete with the fantastic news that we have finally managed to secure the funding for the Project - celebrations all round and so many thanks to all those of you who have supported the scheme - there is little doubt that the strong show of community involvement was a factor in making our bid successful where so many others were not so lucky. Well done Erica, Alan and Rob for persuading Dartmoor National Park to complete the final piece of the funding jigsaw, under the Dartmoor Sustainable Development Fund (£11,000). The lion's share of the funding package has come from DEFRA (The Department of Environment, Food and Rural Affairs). It is now up to us to demonstrate that we really are a BIG community and support the Shop and Meeting room developments.

Now the work really starts! After putting the plans out to tender, we have appointed a well known and highly thought of local firm, Bovey Construction for the build and are hoping for a mid-January start date. If all goes to plan we hope to be open by June 2012. There will obviously be some disruption to the normal goings on at our very busy Village Hall but do rest assured that all efforts will be made to keep this as minimal as possible. With a definite end in sight we would like to update our list of people interested in helping in running the shop. You can also support the project by buying roof slates - they cost £2.00 each and just think of the huge sense of satisfaction you'll get when you can look over our gleaming new slate roof and know that you funded a few (or more than a few should you feel like some serious splashing out!) of those vital slates!
